Auction Items Needed - There will be a silent auction and raffle at the bazaar. We are asking members to ask for donations from local businesses. They do not have to be horse related. Gift certificates, bird seed/houses, decorative items, etc. are some ideas for items for silent auction. Auction items should be valued at a minimum \$25.
